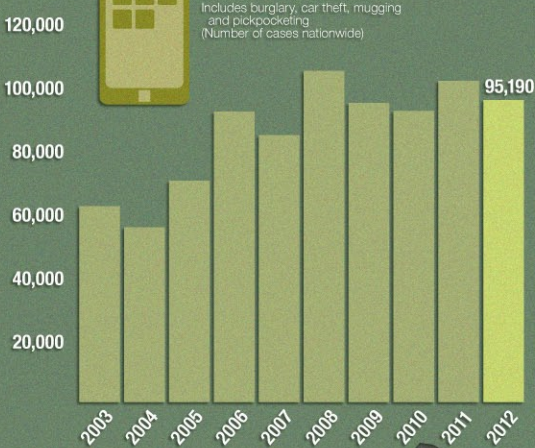


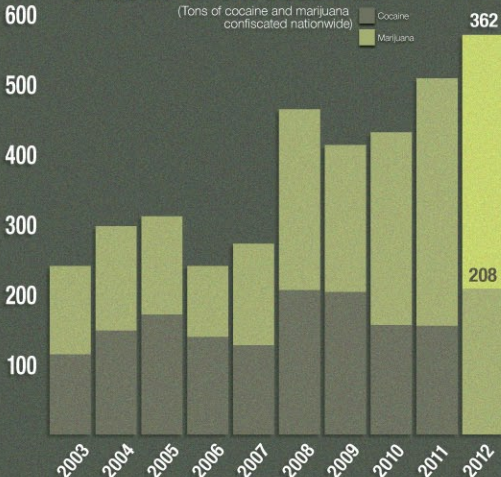
CRIME IN COLOMBIA
